

INTRODUCTION:

Tamulpur Degree College, a naturally beautiful campus surrounded by beautiful greenfield is situated in the heart of Tamulpur with an atmosphere of educational rhythm. It is very near to Tamulpur Commerce College (Jr.), Barkhopa High & Primary School and well known 107 mtg Brigade Army Head Quarter. One can reach the college in a walking distance of 100 mtrs from the main road connecting Rangia, Darranga & Nagrijuli. Commercial vehicles such as bus and different type of vehicle services are available in the main road near the college gate.

CURRICULUM:

The college offers four year degree course (FYUGP)under NEP with English, Economics, Political Science, Philosophy, Education, Assamese and Bodo.

Students who wants to opt for major shall have to select any one subject from the following:

English, Assamese, Bodo, Economics, Education, Political Science, Philosophy

The syllabus and curriculum are subject to change as per the notification of

B.U. from time to time.

RECOGNITION:

Permitted by Gauhati University, Guwahati & Bodoland University, Kokrajhar


- ▶ UG programme in the college shall be of Six Semesters/Eight Semesters covering three/four Calendar Years with multiple entry and exit options. The schedule for Semester System under NEP shall be as follows:
 - (a) First, Third and Fifth and Seventh Semester (including examination)
 - (b) Second, Fourth and Sixth and Eighth Semester (including examination)
 - (c) Summer Vacation and Winter Vacation
- Students' performance will be monitored throughout the semester by continuous assessment in the theory and practical courses. Evaluation of

the students' performance in each of the theory and practical paper will be based on the following:

Internal Evaluation: 30%

External Evaluation or End Semester Examination: 70%

- Internal evaluation will be based on sessional examination, home assignments, group discussion, seminar presentation and library work in each semester.
- External evaluation will be done through a Final Examination at the end of each semester.
- The pass marks in each paper is 40%.
- In each paper, students must secure pass marks in both the internal as well as in the external evaluation separately.
- A student who could not appear or failed in any semester examination will be allowed to clear the same as follows:
 - (a) First Semester with the regular Third Semester examination.
 - (b) Second Semester with the regular Fourth Semester examination.
 - (c) Third Semester with the regular Fifth Semester examination.
 - (d) Fourth Semester with the regular Six Semester examination.
- A student may be allowed to repeat any two of the theory paper in the First, Second, Third and Fourth Semester and may be allowed for betterment of marks in two papers in the fifth Semester or as regulations being provided by the Bodoland University from time to time.
- No repeat / betterment will be allowed in the Practical examination in any semester.
- A student can opt for multiple entry and exit options during his/her study in the college. For exiting after completion of one year, a student shall be awarded a one year UG certificate, for exiting after two years, a student shall be awarded a UG Diploma and at the completion of three years successfully, a student shall be awarded a Degree Certificate. Furthermore, after completion of four years, students with honours shall be entitled to a Bachelor Degree Ceretificate with Honours.
- In Semester system, there is no scope for a student to appear as a Private candidate in any subject.



- ➤ Students have to attend the classes regularly for acquiring eligibility for appearing in the respective examinations. Credit point / mark will be offered on attendance as per B.U. semester system.
- ▶ All students must appear in all the examinations conducted by the college during academic year. Pass marks for all the college examinations is as laid down by B.U. A student must pass all subjects in the Test / Sessional Examination held in the college. Sick bed will be provided to the sick students during all college examinations.
- Students must satisfy the Principal in all respect of regularity in class attendance and study, discipline, behaviour and good conduct.
- The following examinations will be conducted by the College during an academic year.

- ► The existing rules that govern the Semester system are subject to change/ modification as per notification issued by the Bodoland University from time to time.
- A student must attend at least 75% of classes held in each subject during the academic session.

For U.G. 1st and 2nd Semester:

A. Honours Course:

100 Seats are available in each subject

- (i) Assamese (ii) Bodo (iii) Education
- (iv) English (v) Economics (vi) Philosophy
- (vii) Political Science. (Viii) History (IX) Geography

- (a) Students opting Major in any subject shall have to choose another subject as Minor A.
- (b) A student opting Major in any language subject shall be allowed to choose Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC) in the same language. e.g. Students opting Assamese as Honours shall be allowed to study AECC in same language.
- (c) Environmental Science is compulsory in 2nd Semester.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- A student must register all his/her credentials in the Samarth Portal before admission into the college. Prospectus and Application Forms are available in the College Office on payment Rs. 100/- (Rupees one hundred) only.
- Admission into the college is governed by the college admission rules. The Principal's decision regarding admission is final.
- The following documents must be produced at the time of admission.
 - (a) Original Marksheet, Certificate of the last qualifying examination.
 - (b) HSLC Marksheet, Admit Card and Pass Certificate from the Head of the Institute last attendant.
 - (c) Gap Certificate whenever necessary will have to be produced. It has to be issued by a gazzatted officer / head of the institution (Govt. recognized institute) last attended. Candidates having more than three years study gap will not be eligible for admission.
 - (d) Caste Certificate whenever necessary.
 - (e) Two copies of passport sized photograph.
- All candidates must submit self attested copies of (a) and (b) at the time of admission. Students belongings to SC, ST(P), ST(H), OBC or MOBC categories must also submit an attested copy of (d) in addition to (a) and (b). Announcement regarding the commencement of regular classes will be made on the date of admission itself.
